What is your favorite thing about our church


I enjoy being involved in the youth group and helping out in the children's activities.

Pastor's Pen

Dear Friends in Christ,

I am deeply humbled and grateful to serve as your pastor. We certainly have a wonderful (and fun!) congregation that is helping to share the love of Christ with our community in some extraordinary ways. 2021 has certainly had its continued challenges but, together, we have handled every challenge with grace and a steadfast commitment. 2022 will bring new challenges as well as new opportunities to live out the gospel as a community of faith in the heart of Marion.

I thank God each day that I have the privilege of serving with such a vibrant congregation. I want you to know that I pray daily for this church. I pray that God will pour out the Spirit on our church and stir up spiritual revival among us. I pray that we will take discipleship seriously, that God will make every member of our church a committed follower of Jesus Christ in every area of life and that God would create a hunger for holiness in every soul. I pray that God will make each of us a passionate evangelist, sharing the good news of God's transforming love with every person we meet, and that God will use us as missionaries wherever we are in our daily lives. This is my prayer for our church. Everyday.

It has been a fruitful year of mission and there is much to celebrate. We also still have much to do in service to God's mission of making disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world. It's a never-ending work, which is part of the joy of ministry!

This year, **11** young people made their first public profession of faith in Christ

It is our job - as we promised - to do everything we can to strengthen them in their faith. Children and youth are the future pastors, missionaries, lay servants, and leaders of our congregations. If not, I would challenge you to find a way to be involved. You can teach Sunday School, be a confirmation sponsor, go on a mission trip, serve with WWF or MUMC Youth, present children's sermons ... there are any number of ways to help. Children and Youth ministries should be a top priority for our congregation.

One of the areas of ministry we need to address is evangelism. I know that's a scary word for a lot of people. But evangelism should be the joy of every disciple. Think about how you have been supported, comforted, encouraged, challenged, and changed by being part of a community of faith. Now, don't you want others to share in that experience? Don't you want others to know that God loves them? Don't you think the message of God's love in Christ can make a real difference in the world, in our community, and in the hearts and lives of our neighbors? Evangelism is not

primarily about church growth; rather, it is about kingdom growth. As part of our evangelism strategy, we have already taken some important

steps to increase the visibility of our church in the community. We are part of a mailing program that automatically sends a postcard invitation from our church every month to every person who moves within a 5 mile radius of our church. Additionally, we are now advertising on the video broadcast of Marion sports programs as well as the Wynne radio station. Finally, we have new t-shirts that serve as a fun way to let others know about our church. We will be offering evangelism training in the next year and I want to strongly encourage you to take part. You already know the good news. This training will simply give you the awareness and confidence you need to share it.

I'm looking forward to what God has in store for Marion United Methodist Church in 2022. I believe that with the power of the Holy Spirit we will see many signs and wonders of lives being transformed by God's love. Thank you again for your faithful service to our community.
