Greetings Church Friends!

I wanted to provide a brief update on the financial position of our church. As a member, I would have found this information helpful and insightful. Now that I serve on the finance committee, I would like to provide this information to you all consistently.

Obviously, we have faced a series of challenges over the past several years, but fortunately, 2020 and 2021 were very good from a financial perspective. Congregational giving was strong in both years and met all of the operational and building needs of our church. However, 2022 has started much slower.

Through the end of June, giving for the operations is lower by ~15% from our budget; and giving for the building is lower by ~25% from budget. This is not a cause for panic; our Church does have reserves to meet shortfalls, but I ask that each of you evaluate your current position and your giving to the mission and ministry of our church.

We will continue to provide updates over the balance of the year, but please prayerfully consider the financial support that you can provide to our church.
