Report from the Finance Committee

Fall is a wonderful time in Marion. The heat and humidity give us a break. We get college football every Saturday. Hullabaloo, Halloween, Thanksgiving....

But the fall is also a very important time in the financial planning of the church. As a church, we take an assessment of how our year is going, and look to project into the next year.

Did you know that it takes nearly one million dollars each year to operate and maintain our church? Our largest "expense" is for the people that lead our ministry and our missions (full list on the back of your bulletin). Our second largest expense is making our mortgage payments on our beautiful facility. From there, we pay utilities, insurance, maintenance – all of the normal, everyday expenses.


Each year our Church Council approves an annual budget for the upcoming year, and I am pleased to report that in 2020, 2021 and 2022 we have actually spent less than we have budgeted to spend! Also, congregational giving in 2020 and 2021 was greater than our expenses – so we ended each of those years with a surplus. However, 2022 has been a different story – while expenses have been kept in check – congregation giving has not met those expenses. It is not a cause for panic (our church does have reserves to meet shortfalls), but it is something that I would ask each of you to reflect upon. We have 2 months left in the year, so please prayerfully consider the financial contribution that you can make to our church over these next 2 months. Every bit helps.

Further, all throughout the month of November, we will be asking you to complete and return an Estimate of Giving card for 2023 – a way for you to express your financial commitment to our church. This is OUR Church – and the money that we give allows us to further God's work in our community and make disciples of Jesus Christ.




