Come now, you who say, "Today or tomorrow we will go to such and such a town and spend a year there, doing business and making money." Yet you do not even know what tomorrow will bring. What is your life? For you are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes — James 4:13-14, NRSVue

Wow! That was fast! One more year has come and gone and a new one is upon us.
